

TOWN OF CHEVY CHASE
COUNCIL MEETING
May 12, 2021

This is a summary of the Council's actions at the May 12, 2021 Council meeting. Detailed meeting minutes are posted once they are approved by the Town Council at the next regular Council meeting.

I. GENERAL BUSINESS

- Newly elected Councilmembers Joel Rubin and Joy White read the oath of office.
- Voted unanimously to appoint Council officers, as follows:

 - Joy White, Treasurer
 - Joel Rubin, Secretary
 - Ellen Cornelius Ericson, Community Liaison
- Voted unanimously to appoint Council liaisons to Town committees, as follows:
 - Climate and Environment: Joy White
 - Community Relations: Irene Lane
 - Land Use: Ellen Cornelius Ericson
 - Long Range Planning: Irene Lane
 - Public Services: Barney Rush
 - Racial Justice Special Committee: Joel Rubin
 - 4-H Center Special Committee: Joel Rubin, with another Councilmember attending as an observer on a rotational basis.
- Voted unanimously to approve meeting minutes.
- Discussed and accepted April 2021 financial report.
- Heard Town Manager's report.
- Heard public comments.

II. VARIANCE HEARINGS

- Voted unanimously to approve variances, with conditions, for driveway width and right-of-way hedge at 7404 Meadow Lane.

III. COUNCIL DISCUSSIONS

- Discussed ideas for community outreach and engagement on the redevelopment of the 4-H property. Asked the 4-H Center Special Committee to assist with developing questions to pose to residents about this matter.
- Discussed Thrive Montgomery 2050 and expressed support for a proposed coalition letter regarding this issue. Councilmember Lane agreed to distribute the final letter to the Council for review.
- Voted unanimously to approve a proclamation for National Gun Violence Awareness Day. Discussed ideas for Town recognition of this day.
