At 7:00 p.m. in the Town Hall, the Town Council held a work session via teleconference to discuss and develop a position on the lack of funding for the Capital Crescent Trail Tunnel in the County Executive's proposed FY21-26 Capital Improvements Program. The Council discussed the importance of the CCT Tunnel project for public safety; the prior commitments to the project made by the County Council; the Town's disappointment with the lack of project funding; and the need to urge the County Council to fund the project in the County's 6-year Capital Improvements Program. Mayor Rush moved to approve the Council's position on this matter and to send a letter to the County Council expressing this position.
