

If the Purple Line comes to our Town's northern border, should the tracks or the Trail be closest to the Town?

The Mitigation Advisory Group (MAG) is busy at work and would like your input on an important mitigation issue: The State's plans call for the proposed Purple Line Light Rail tracks to run alongside our Town's northern border, and the Capital Crescent Trail to run north of the tracks, farther from our community.

MAG members will discuss the likely impacts of the proposed alignment at its next meeting, including:

- Visual, sound and vibration impacts
- Impacts on terrain and water runoff
- Access to the Trail and safety issues
- Quality of the Trail experience
