1) Commemoration for the service to the PSC of Roy Gordon, who recently passed away, and Arthur Schatzkin, who volunteered on behalf of the community as well. PSC decided to put a note in the “Forecast” expressing our gratitude for their service. Town policy does not support such statements.

2) Additional Members: the PSC has lost several members due to attrition and/or personal tragedy; PSC determined that it needs 3 – 4 more Members and would like to put a notice in the “Town Crier” to seek more volunteers.

3) Lynn Drive sidewalks: PSC recommends “no” to the Town Council on moving forward with laying sidewalks at Lynn Drive. The rationale is that the “demand, safety, and feasibility” criteria haven’t been met, which includes a lack of resident demand for the sidewalks, per survey from the street’s residents. In addition, there will be cost avoidance by the Town by not implementing what would likely be an expensive project.

4) Street Lighting: Ongoing discussion about options, with a document to be produced for PSC review.

5) Handicapped Parking requests (per Town Council): PSC recommends developing a process/policy for how to deal with the handicapped parking issues pending Town review; Action: request regulations about “handicapped parking spaces” for residents from Warren

6) 4006 Rosemary: PSC reviewing the parking near the school and the accompanying regulations; will make a recommendation at next PSC meeting on 3/10
