The meeting was called to order at 7:35pm.

Speed bumps, Chatham Road/Aspen Street, Speed Bump Policy

The Chair stated that the Town Council referred the current Speed Bump Policy back to the PSC for revision and to consider more specific guidelines for installation.

The data from the traffic study conducted on Aspen Street and Chatham Road in March 2007 were reviewed.

The Montgomery County rules guiding installation for speed bumps were discussed.

On the whole, the Committee members wish to have additional information regarding speed bumps and other traffic control approaches as well as professional advice on the matter.

The minutes of the April 9, 2007 meeting were approved.

Subcommittee Reports/Planning:

Electricity: PSC will inquire with the Town Manager regarding the status of the PEPCO rate increase and their accountability for service.

Water: There will be a meeting with builders and the water board on approaches to the ordinance.

Security: Will meet with the private security firm and the coordinator of the Montgomery county Police presence in the Town. Implementation of Neighborhood Watch does not appear to be under development by any other Town committee and will be investigated by PSC.

Information Technology: Members want to discuss IT needs and opportunities with the Council. Other committees should consider how IT could help meet their goals. The PSC is willing to assist in that effort. All of these points were made at the Town's Annual Meeting.

Sidewalk Policy: The Sidewalk Policy submitted by the PSC will be considered at the regularly scheduled May meeting of the Town Council.
