- Discussed FY11 revenue projections and potential budget cuts. Directed staff to prepare insert for FORECAST describing potential savings of, and rationale for, proposed cuts.

- Heard report from Councilmember Lang describing Council/Resident dialogue sessions. Referred idea to Community Relations Committee for consideration.
- Heard report from Councilmember Barnes on status of Land Use Handbook and contractual issue with consultant.
