Street Tree Removal August – September 2010

This is to inform the Environmental Committee and Tree Board of the removal of hazardous street trees of size, during the next several weeks.

The reasons for the removal of the trees are given on the attached photos.

A Scarlet Oak at 7707 Meadow Lane (on Blackthorn St.) is hazardous due to extensive decay at the base of the tree as shown in the photo below.

The Pin Oak at 3911 Underwood St. is hazardous
due to continued decline and dieback of large
structural branches in the canopy.

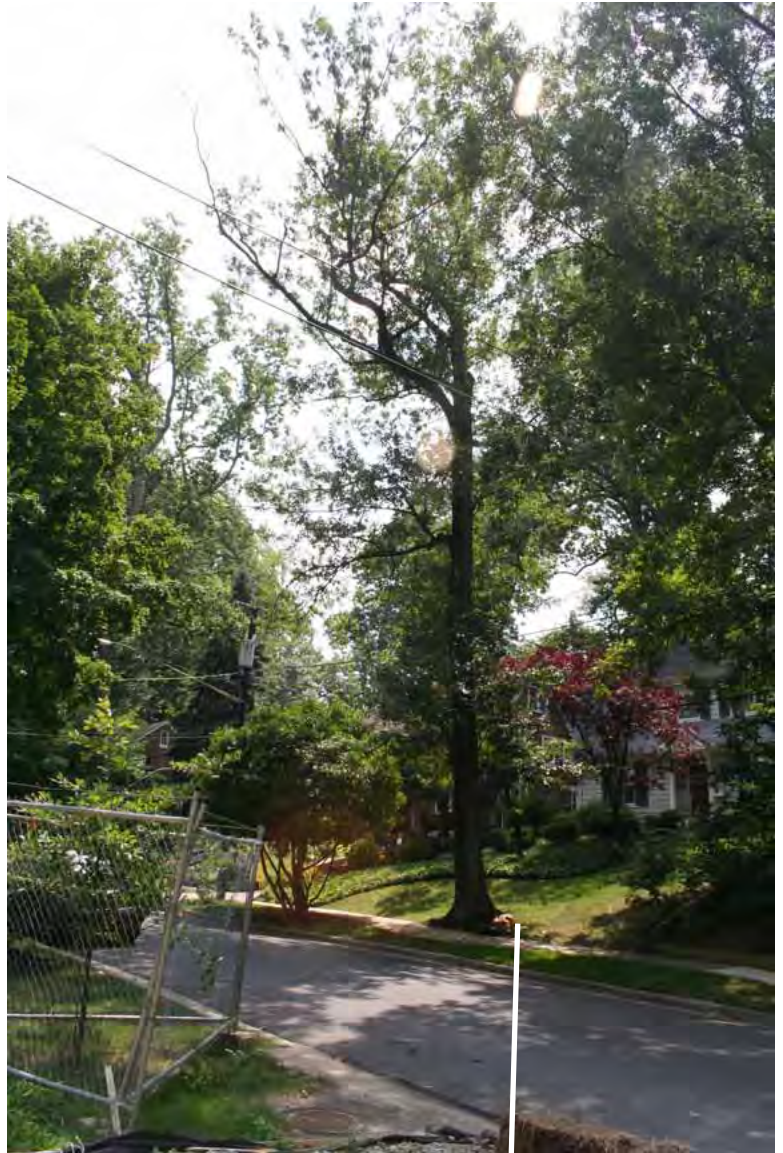

The Blackgum at 6820 Meadow Lane is hazardous due active fungal decay at the base of the tree and continued decline of the canopy.

The Pin Oak at 4101 Blackthorn St. is hazardous due to decay in the upper main trunk. This tree developed partially protected from winds by the 3 large canopy trees that were blown over by the July 25th storm. The tree is now exposed and susceptible to wind-throw.

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
