Residents and guests attended by videoconference.

At 1:45 p.m., the Town Council held a work session to discuss clarifying the Town's policy regarding the prospective sale of the 4-H Center property. The Council also discussed the possible retention of consultants in support of the Town's engagement on this matter.

Councilmember Rush moved to focus Town efforts until May 5 on working with potential bidders for the 4-H property rather than on a stand-alone bid to purchase the 4-H property. Mayor Baskir seconded the motion, which passed by a vote of 3-2, with Councilmembers Ericson and Rubin opposed.

Mayor Baskir moved to start the process of seeking public finance counsel to provide advice on Town financing opportunities related to the sale of the 4-H property. Councilmember Rush seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Mayor Baskir moved to reach out to real estate advisors to discuss the Town's position related to the prospective sale of the 4-H property and to request proposals for services. Councilmember Rubin seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 3:00 p.m.
